

Are you sleeping on the streets?

It is not illegal to sleep on the streets in Denmark, but you have to follow these rules:



You must pack up your things in the morning.



You must put your waste in the public waste bins.



You are not allowed to make a permanent camp, for example by putting up a tent or making a fireplace.



You are not allowed to be noisy or disturb your surroundings. Or in any other way to make people feel unsafe.



You must always use a toilet. It is illegal to use the streets as a toilet.



If you are more people sleeping in the same place, this can make others feel unsafe.

If you don't follow the rules, the police can give you a fine and they can ban you (zoneforbud) from the municipality, where you broke the rules. If you break the ban (the zoneforbud), you can be sent to prison.
